Dear Students, Parents and Caregivers,

Parent Teacher interviews were held this week and I have heard good feedback regarding the sharing of information. Teachers and parents appreciate having the opportunity to discuss any concerns and learn more about the learning that is underway in each class.



The requirements of my job have seen me off site for a number of days recently. Last Friday I participated in our Torrens Valley Partnership Review. Principals from across our partnership along with Tim Wilson (Education Director), Liz Matheson (PC) and Leonie Feutrill (SLLIP) underwent an in-depth review of our current and future work.

The NAPLAN online trial originally scheduled for Thursday 28th March was delayed until today. The trial is not to test the students but rather to test the system and its ability to cope with the high demand. Our trial went well with everyone able to log on and complete the test. The online test is an omnibus and not a full test of any of the areas.

Our fundraising committee will be organising a second hand uniform shop starting next term. Children grow so quickly that they often outgrow their school uniforms leaving them in good condition for someone else to wear. If you are sorting out uniforms during the holidays, please consider donating any items of school uniform that are in good condition. There will be a collection box in the office. Second hand uniforms will be available at very reasonable prices twice per term from 2.30 until 3.15. More information to follow when we know the days and dates.

During the school holidays work will commence on the crossing and car park upgrades. It will not be completed by the time school starts next term. I am thanking you in advance for your cooperation and patience while this work is underway. Wherever possible the work will be undertaken after 9.00am and before 3.00pm to reduce disruptions to drop off and pickup of children.

Our long awaited Football and Soccer goals will be installed next week. Thank you to our hard working fundraising committee.

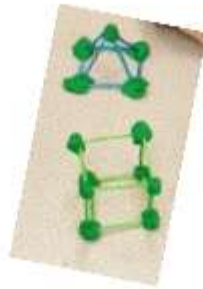

I hope everyone has a safe and happy holiday.

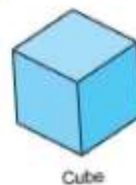
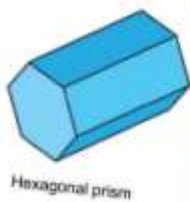

One task involved manipulatives (matchsticks and playdough), where students were asked to build a 3D shape. They were then asked to respond to multiple questions in regards to the shape they had created.





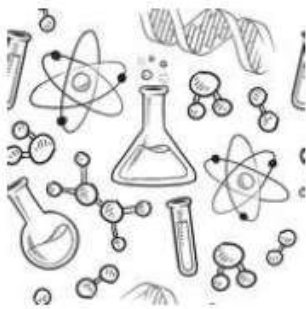

CANCELLATIONS FOR VACATION CARE REQUIRE 1 WEEK'S WRITTEN NOTICE - (5 WORKING DAYS).
 Cancellations without the required notice will incur the usual Vacation Care fee.

Please note that enrolments will automatically end if your child does not attend care for eight continuous weeks, including vacation care. Once we submit a new attendance, this creates a new enrolment, and you will need to confirm the new enrolment through your MyGov Centrelink online account or Express Plus app.

ATTENTION PARENTS/GUARDIANS...

\$3 Lunch available – Children can choose noodles, or mini pizza; plus veggie sticks, and fruit for snacks.

Food A packed lunch, including morning/afternoon snack and a drink **MUST** be sent with each child. We only provide lunch if stated on the program.
